


CHÂTEAU MOULIN DES GRAVES SAINT-ÉMILION

Château « Moulin des Graves », situated in Vignonet village, next to Dordogne river, in the south of Saint-Emilion, has been a familial property for 3 generation. This wine, with mostly Merlot grapes is a round and supple Saint-Emilion with a very expressive bouquet.

Wine making

Manual harvest. Tradition wine-making process and ageing with control of the temperature. 4 to 5 weeks vatting.

Tasting note

Garnet-red robe. Beautiful fresh nose of red fruits with a touch of violet cassis. In the mouth, the wine is frank, round with fat. The final has ripe tanins, silky and elegant.

Food pairings

To match with : duck filet, mushroom cream soup, sheep's cheese.
