Recently acquired by Livon vineyards, Fattoria Colsanto is located in the Commune of Bevagna (Umbria) in D.O.C.G. Montefalco. The property has an extension of 50 acres, including an eighteenth century farm house, with a phenomenal view overlooking Assisi and Spello.

REGION: Umbria
WINEMAKER: Rinaldo Stocco
VARIETAL: 75% Sangiovese, 25% Sagrantino
COLOR: Intense ruby red
BOUQUET: Red fruit, such as cherry and raspberry
TASTE: A robust, full-bodied wine with intense red fruit flavors, soft tannins and a long finish
AGEING: 15 months – 70% of the wine in barrique and 30% of wine in stainless steel tanks followed by a long period of bottle refinement
VINEYARD SIZE: 15 acres
YIELD PER VINE: 2.2 lbs
CASES PRODUCED: 9,000 bottles
FOOD PAIRING: Beef, polenta, robust stews and aged cheeses
SERVING TEMP: 68° F (20° C)
