Owned by the Lawson family and guided by a collaborative winemaking team, the focus is on consistency, thoughtful sourcing, and wines that are authentic to Sonoma.

A Cool Place to Grow Grapes

Russian River Valley is known for its cool climate and long growing season, which make it especially well-suited for Chardonnay. Morning fog and steady afternoon breezes slow ripening and help preserve natural acidity, giving growers more control over harvest timing. These conditions encourage balance and structure rather than speed or excess. The result is a growing region that consistently supports quality and precision year after year.

Tasting Notes:

Bright and focused, this Russian River Valley Chardonnay opens with fresh citrus layered with hints of ripe pear and subtle stone fruit. Stainless steel fermentation preserves lift and clarity, while aging in French oak adds gentle texture and soft spice without overwhelming the fruit. Pairs beautifully with roast chicken, grilled seafood, creamy pasta dishes and soft, mild cheeses.
