The 2016 Barbaresco is a full, generous and soft wine that takes the Nebbiolo grape to a more accessible and immediate style. The fruit is bright and ready to drink. This young vintage is ready straight out of the gate and would make for a lovely lunch with a warm pasta dish on a cold day. Production is ample with 45,000 bottles made.

Old wood, bees wax and cinnamon aromas. Decent concentration on the palate with grippy tannins, nicely integrated warm alcohol and a rose petals finish.



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BARBARESCO 2016  
The nose is shy at first but eventually reveals dar-skinned fruit, violet and culinary spice. Firmly structured, the palate is youthfully austere, revealing red cherry, cranberry and star anise alongside close-grained tannin and vibrant acidity. A hint of orange zest marks the close. It's still tightly wound and needs time.
